Lived at 27 Thurlow Road 1873 - 93.

Frederick Hill, younger brother of Rowland Hill, resided in Thurlow Road
1847. Worked for Post Office in succession to Sir Rowland. In 1870s
was member of the Hampstead Board of Guardians.

Ellen & Constance Hill lived at 110 Fregnal (eg 1910 & 1928 D)
