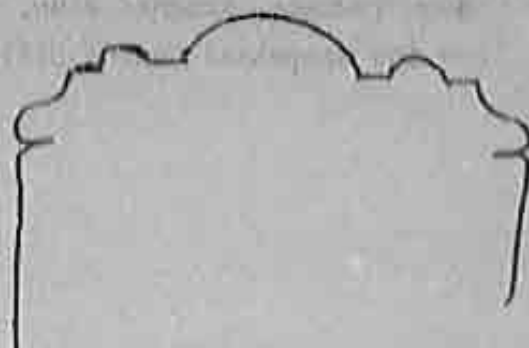

The family/grave of George Paxon of this Parish/wherein are deposited the remains/of/

- Miss James Latwyche } his son-in-law, who/died Augst 23rd 1836/in his 42nd year.
- John Paxon } fourth son of the above/who died Aug. 2nd 1844/aged 47 years.

- George, 2nd son } of the above John Paxon/who died July 18th 1861/ Aged 29 years.
- Priscilla, widow } of the above John Paxon/who died Oct. 16th 1862/in her 59th year.

William Frederick Paxon/died June 3rd 1879 aged 36 years/son of William Paxon.
