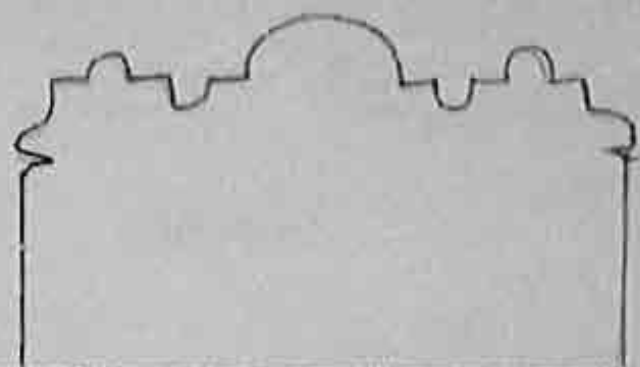

Jenson South Bank, Regents Park who departed this life July 26th
A.D. 1836, aged 19 years.
