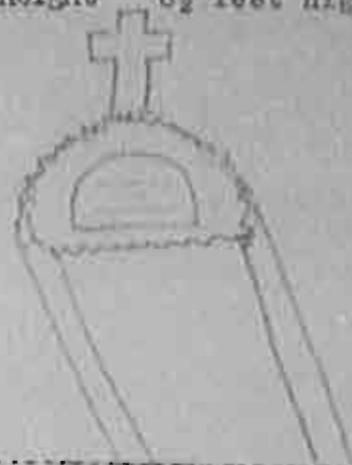

 METCALFE / who died 1st January 1918 / Aged 49 /  
 "Stay with me, The long night is here /  
 "Hold my cold hand that I may feel you near /  
 "So while the sacred silent hours creep /  
 "I'll understand and sink to sleep /  
 "Close my eyes as you would tenderly /  
 "Mourn not my loss. You lov'd me faithfully /  
 "Then when the cold grey dawn breaks silently /  
 "Hold up the Cross and pray for us." /  
 Also of CATHERINE, his widow / Born 10th February 1867 /  
 Died 5th January 1921.
