

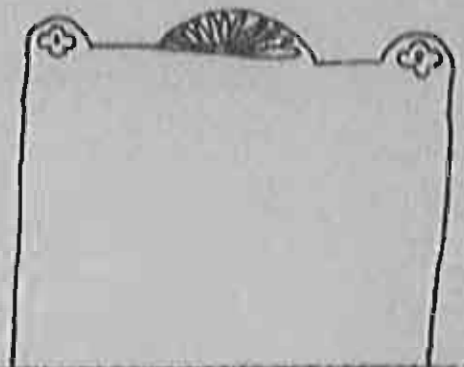

 who died March 30th 1850 / at Melbourne Port Phillip /
the ship then anchored in Hudson Bay / from an accident on shore
