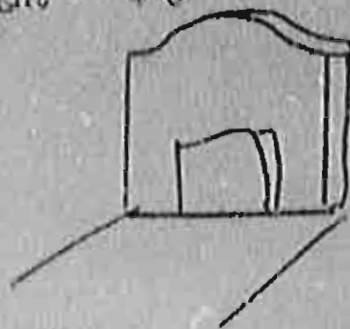

Sacred to the memory of / Mr William Spillman/  
 brother of Mrs John Hayter/ of this Parish/  
 who died June 18th 1831 Aged 60

Also Mrs Elizabeth Hayter/ sister of the above/  
 who died 29th April 1834/ aged 65 years/

Also Mr John Hayter/ husband of the above/  
 who died 14 Nov 1855/ aged 73 years/ his end was peace.

Also Katherine Woods/ sister in law of the above/  
 who died 19 Sept 1868/ aged 73 years/

Also Charlotte Hayter/ widow of the above/ who died 4th June  
 aged 67 years/

Faithfull friends and parents dear/  
 A tender Father, Mother, Aunt sleepeth here  
 Who labored hard with toil and care  
 With a reward from God to share.
