

The Radfords were poets, Fabians and friends of D.H. Lawrence. They first met him in 1909, when they lived at 16 East Heath Road.

During World War I they were at 32 Well Walk and D.H. and Frieda frequently stayed with them. Lawrence described one such visit in his novel Kangaroo.
