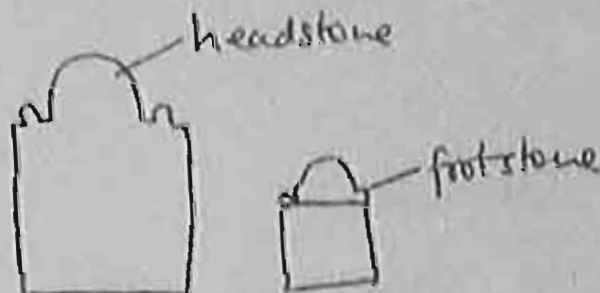

Legible:

Sacred to the memory of Mrs Sarah Pawsey, the beloved wife of Mr. Samuel Pawsey of this parish who departed this life January 25th 1842 in the 59th year of her age Life is uncertain; death is sure / sin is the wound and Christ is the cure / Also Charles William Pawsey who died at Peckham July 14th 1862 / aged 42 years / "Blessed are they that sleep in the Lord".

Also Mr. Samuel Pawsey / husband of the above, / who departed this life / November 16th 1862 / aged 73 years

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God"
