

Cecil Sharp, the folk musician, married the daughter of Priestley Birch in 1893.

Their last home was at 4 Maresfield Gardens.

He died in 1924 and was cremated at Golders Green.



(The gravestone is located in the north-western corner of the cemetery.)

The gravestone is made of Portland stone and is in good condition. It is surrounded by a low wall of the same material. The base of the stone is inscribed with the name 'Cecil Sharp' and the dates '1859-1924'. The dome is inscribed with 'Maresfield Gardens' and the cross is inscribed with 'Golders Green'.
