

Robert Shout is listed as a landowner in the Tithe Map of Hampstead 1841, according to the Index, but it is missing from the collection. Sec H 912 - 421 / 1841

Lived in Treherne House, West End.

Robert SHOUT sculpted a large number of monuments during 1778 - 1823, e.g. in Emmanuel College Chapel, Cambridge.

In 1809 he took his son Charles as apprentice.
