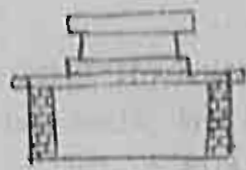

on top

Here lies the body of Ann late wife of John Merivale now of this Parish formerly of Barton Place in the county of the City of Exeter Esquire who died June 21st 1829 in the 76th year of her age Matt 5 B Also of the above John Merivale Esq who died July 26th 1831 in his 79th year Feb 6 15 Also in memory of Herman Louis the beloved child of Herman & Caroline Merivale who died May 19th 1838 aged two years and eight months Here also lies the body of Reginald grandson of the above named John and Ann Merivale late of the Registrars office in Chancery who died May 1st 1841 in his 31st year To holy as the dark womb the sower commits his seed in joyfull trust By blessing from the great Bestower To see it blossom in the dust so in earth's mothers lap with mourning A seed more precious we intomb In hope that from its rest returning It will flourish in immortal bloom.

South side

Here lies also the mortal remains of John Lewis Mallet Esq long resident in Hampstead Born Dec 6th 1775 Died Feb 9 1861 Pn GXIX 96 (I see that all things come to an end)

East side

Here lies also the mortal remains of Frances wife of J.L. Mallet Esq of this place and daughter of John and Ann Merivale Born 22 July 1776 Died 8 Oct 1851 There is stirring up a light for the righteous and joyfull ladness for such as are true hearted PS 97 W are also interred the mortal remains of John Herman Merivale Esq late of Barton Place Exeter And of Bedford Square London one of the commissioners of Her Majesty's Court of Bankruptcy Born August 5 1779 deceased April 25th 1864 ...for ye know not what now your....comes Matt 25 13. (at what hour or day the Son of Man shall come) PTO
