

MERIVALE John, Herman (1779-1844) scholar and minor poet; Barrister who practised in Chancery and Bankruptcy Court; Chancery Commissioner; Bankruptcy Commissioner (DNB) Part of literary circle. His sister married J.L. Mallet (Barrett II, 122) (see below). ?Lived next to Joanna Baillie.

MERIVALE Herman, (1806-74) permanent Under-Secretary India Office previously Professor of political economy at Oxford; writer (DNB)

MALLET, John Lewis, son of Mallet du Pan (Barrett II, 122) of Audit Office and lived at Belmont House (Newton Cutting Book 69; Baines appendix D, 1549); father of Rt. Hon Sir Lewis Mallet (Privy Counsellor and Permanent Secretary India Office); mentioned in Pigot's Directory (1840)

MERIVALE, John (d. 1831) presumably the eponymous amateur artist, who was friend and patron and pupil of Francis Towne. They sketched in the Lake District c. 1786. (V & A Exhibition, 1984)
