

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or PS)

Millward p28, no. 23

S. Side Sacred to the memory of George Todd Esq^(sic) of Bellsite in this parish/who departed this life/on the 4th day Jan'y 1829/aged 67 years.

E. Side Sacred/to the memory of/Mrs. Helena Dorothea Stegman/rellict of the Counsellor Frederick Stegman/of Lieb^{au} (*)who departed this life/the 31 day of Jan'y 1816/aged 65 years

N. Side Sacred to the memory of/Sophia Helene Frederica Todd/rellict of George Todd Esq/who departed this life 2 Jan'y 1851/who was buried at Dresden/Also of Helen Alexandra Todd/daughter of George Todd Esq and of Sophia Helene Frederica his wife/who departed this life on 7 June 1866/and was buried at Kensal Green Cemetery.

Notes * probably Liebenau in N. Germany
 Aulic Council (Reichshofrat) = Court of Holy Roman Empire
 Great variety of spelling by Millward and other recorders for Helene and Frederica.
