

Emma Hale's notes

Edward and Lurline Jay - parents of St. Ann Douglas Jay's Pa. as minister.

From 1857 - 22, they lived at 30 West South Street, and from 1857 until death at 17 Hill Street.

1858 Directory gives Edward JAY, M.D., M.D., but he is not in Jay's dir.

He trained as a barrister, became Parliamentary Secretary for King Edward's Hospital Fund for London and, in Second World War, was secretary of the Red Cross Committee for fund-raising in schools and colleges.
