

DNB: 'Scholar and minor poet. Published law reports and translations from Greek and Roman poetry.' His daughter married John Mallet (see CH 72). His father was Presbyterian minister at Sleaford and Tavistock.
2 sons also in DNB - Charles (1808-93), Dean of Ely, translated Keats's Hyperion into Latin; and Herman 1806-74, Under Secretary for India.

Barratt: Barrister friend of Joanna Baillie. His parents lived next door, in Windmill Hill. He and his son, Reginald, and his sister (? daughter) Frances, with her husband Mallet, are buried in the churchyard. His son was historian etc.
