

These were all sons of William Selwyn (1775-1855) of Lincoln's Inn, who lived in Church Row, where the Bishop was born (DNB). 'A magnificent service' was held in the church in 1909 to commemorate the centenary of the Bishop's baptism here (Koch p. 7). Selwyn College, Cambridge, was erected by public subscription in his memory, 1882. Sir Charles was also born in Church Row (DNB)
