In memory of / Josiah Holford Esquire / and Magdalen his wife / who lived
many years in this Parish / highly respected and esteemed /
The former died on the 27th of April 1817 / aged 90 /
The latter lost her life by an accident / on the 19th of January 1812 / aged 73
Their remains were deposited / in the vault of this church / near to the
communion table /

* Coat of arms: Argent a greyhound passant noble
(crest) Greyhound noble

In escutcheon (Gwynedd or Gwent, County Monmouth) Gules a lion passant rampant.
