

Josiah (probably son of Sarah, o.f., Chatelaine of Mrs Holford's garden,  
1746) was a general merchant with offices in Southampton Row, and later  
the City.

Magdalen (nee Price) was an heiress from Carmarthen.

They lived first at Windmill House, then in 1776 moved to 22 Church Row,  
and finally in 1782 to Holly Hill House (site of UCS Junior School).

Josiah helped the Parish School with the Philo-Investigists, of which he  
was the President after Spencer Perceval.
