

L. side: In / loving remembrance / of / Harriet Stedall / who died July 31 1881 aged 63 / "In the mist of life we are in death" / Also of Henry Stedall / who died March 24 1885 aged 65 / Afflictions sore long time I bore / physicians were in vain till God was pleased my life to ease / and take me from my pain / Also 5 children of the above / Also of Harriet Mary Stedall / who died suddenly on Decr 20 1894 / aged 44 years / Be thou good and faithful servant / Enter thou now in the joys of the Lord"
