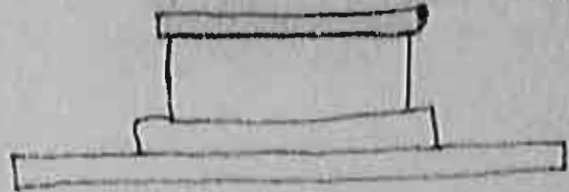

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) ^{Millward p. 794, tomb 503}

North side: This stone is rendered sacred by the name of / Robert Milligan Esqre. / whose remains are deposited beneath it / He died at Roslyn, in this Parish, the 21st of May 1809 / in the 63rd year of his age /

Here also are interred the mortal remains of / Jean Milligan / widow of the above named Robert Milligan Esqre. / who died at Roslyn 14th of January 1820 / aged 62 years /

South side: Sacred to the memory of / Henry Davidson Milligan / of Roslyn, Hampstead, who died / at sea October 2nd 1817 / in the 27th year of his age /

Sacred also to the memory of / David Milligan Esqre. / second son of Robert Milligan Esqre., who died at Spanish Town Jamaica / after an illness of only five days February 16th 1818 aged 28 years /

East side: Here are deposited the remains of / Justina Milligan / second daughter of Robert and Jean Milligan / Born March 12th 1786 / and died at Leamington Spa August 31st 1840 /

Also those of / Duncan Davidson Milligan, Esqre / fourth son of the above mentioned / Robert and Jean Milligan; / Born June 27th 1793 / and died at / Brighton Dec. 4th 1846 /
