

Mr. Robert Milligan was a wealthy West India merchant, originator of the West India Docks at Poplar. A statue of him was erected at the dock gates soon after his death, but was removed in 1943 to allow for the transport of aircraft. The Milligans lived at Rosslyn House from 1803/09. The third son, Henry, died at sea off the Isle of Wight.
