Sacred / to the memory of / Mrs Eleanor SMALLEY / the wife of Cornwall SMALLEY Esq /
She departed this life the 26th February 1800 / in the 39th year of her age /

The remains of four of their children are / deposited in this vault /

George SMALLEY 27 July 1792 aged 7 months / Sarine (?) SMALLEY died 20 March 1790
aged 9 months / Henry SMALLEY died Feby 1798 aged 10 months / Henry SMALLEY died
6 March 1800 aged 17 days

Here also are deposited the remains of Cornwall SMALLEY Esq / Russian Merchant / who
was born at Chesterfield in the County of Derby / 28 ... 1756 married to the above
named Eleanor daughter of Edward TIERNEY Merchant / of Limerick who died 6th Nov. 1788 /
and died at Hampstead 29 October 1800 / in the 45 year of his age / highly respected
for the singular mildness of his manners / and for his unremitting attention to the
scrupulous discharge / of every Christian and social duty / He left three sons and
a daughter Cornwall, Edward, Susannah and George / to bewail the early loss of both
their excellent parents /

Cornwall SMALLEY died at Worthing / Sussex 11 Aug 1859 aged 69 / lies buried in this
vault / He was Vicar of Brailen Warwick / and afterwards incumbent of St Matthew's
Dayswater / in this County where a tablet is erected to his memory /
