Hic sepultus est / Robertus Hunter junr / bonae indolis et maximo spe juvenis obt 13 Mar decimo quinto anno aetatis anno domini millesimo septim ... et octigentimo octavo / Flebilis ille occidit (indistinct).

1977: The first two lines can be made out, but all the rest has gone.
