

The Platt family lived at Childs Hill House, on the corner of  
Platts Lane, which was given this name after them about 1830.

DNB note on Thomas Pell Platt: (1798-1852), orientalist;  
fellow, Trinity College, Cambridge, 1820; MA 1822;  
acted for some years as librarian of the British and Foreign  
Bible Society, and (c. 1825) collated for the society the  
Ethiopic texts of the New Testament; also prepared an edition  
of the Syriac gospels, 1820, and an Amharic version of the  
Bible, 1844.
