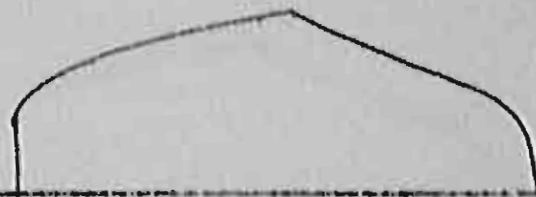

East face (uppermost):

Sacred / to the memory of / Charles / second son of / Samuel & Jane Knapp / who died Sepr. 17 1859 / Aged 1- years /

Also / Ann Francis / sister of the above / died April 21st 1864 / Aged 15 yrs / In love they lived in peace they died / Their lives were asked but God denied /

Also Samuel / Father of the above / who died Dec 26th 1869 / Aged 61 years /

Also Jane Charlotte / wife of the above Samuel Knapp / who died Aug 21st 1875 / aged 59 / We all like forest trees do stand / Some are doomed to fall / We all must go at Gods command / And thus obey his call /

Also Alice Jane / the beloved wife of Henry Tucker / and daughter of the above S. and J.G. Knapp / who departed this life / September 8th 1884 aged 41 years / Tho' lost to sight to memory dear / Thy will be done.
