plumber, / who died Oct. 3rd 1795 / Aged 44 Years /

Also of Richard Mallard, / Son of the above, / who met his Fate by bathing
in the / Middle Pond on Hamptlead Heath / on the 8th day of September 1804 /
in the 19th Year of his Age /

Also of the above Mr. Stephen Mallard, / who departed this Life the 22nd
Aug. 1822, / Aged 65 Years /

Also of / William Mallard, / Son of the above, / who died Sept. 30th 1828,
aged 46 years / An affectionate husband and tender parent /

Also of Jane, / the second wife of / the above Mr. Stephen Mallard, / who
died Dec. 7th 1838, / aged 79 Years /

Also Mary, wife of the above Mr. William Mallard, died Oct. 25th 1847,
aged 69 years. (This inscription apparently seen by Millward, but no
trace remains now.)
