

(Local History reference - a shop in High Street, and ground opening to Back Lane, belonging to Stephen Mallard, plumber and glazier. Manor Minute Book 1783-1809, p. 339 date 1804, and p. 343 date 1805.)

"Our Mallard family goes back about 400 years in Hampstead," wrote a descendant, Beatrice Tree, in 1974. She claimed that her uncle Bernard, on a visit from Australia in 1922, found a Mallard grave "near the choir door", dated 1638; also that her family were connected with the De Mallards of Alsace, owners of 5 chateaux.

Stephen is plumber, glazier and painter, High St in 1805-7 Directory

William was a churchwarden and his name is on one of the wardens' staves in the church on Xmas.
