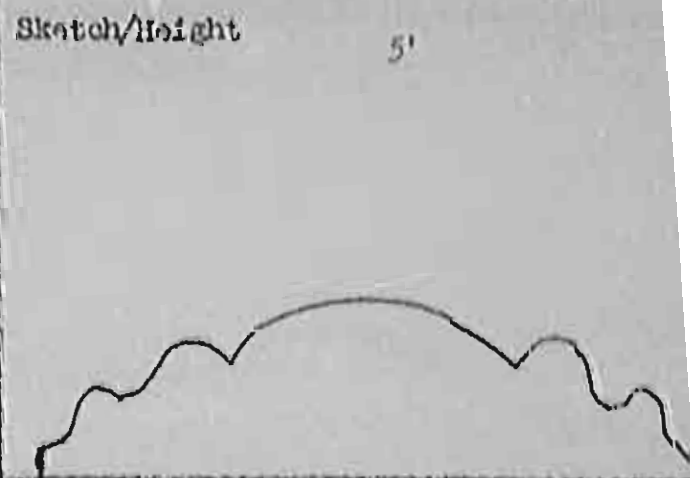

- Henry Anos Holroyd, their / Grandson died 25 Feby. 1794 / Aged 9 Months /
- Frederick Court Holroyd, their / Grandson died 19th Decr. 1798 / Aged One Year /
- Esau Holroyd / (Father of the above / George Holroyd) / died 4th Septe. 1774 / Aged 84. /
- Henry Bowley / (Father of the above / Eleanor Holroyd) / died 26th May 1777 / Aged 79 /
