Jane their third daughter / who died Feby 27 1871 aged 69 years /

Robert their second surviving son / late Captain in the Indian Army / who
 died May 29 1873 aged 70 years /

Caroline their youngest daughter / who died Dec. 18 1876 aged 73 years /

Elizabeth their second daughter / who died April 5th 1871 aged 51 years /
