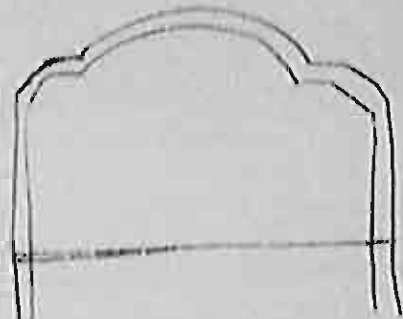

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward 471 / 93

Here / lie the ashes of / Mr John Hindley / of Stanhope Street, May Fair, London / originally of King Street, Liverpool / who under peculiar Disadvantages Which to common minds / would have been a bar to any exertion raised himself from all obscure situations / of birth and fortune / by his own industry and frugality / to the enjoyment of a moderate competency. / He attained a peculiar excellence / in penmanship and drawing / without the instructions of a master / and to eminence in arithmetic / the useful and higher branches of / the mathematics / by going to school only a year and eight months

He / died a bachelor / on the 24th day of October 1807 / in the 55th year of his age / and without forgetting / relations, friends or acquaintances / Bequeathed (sic) one fifth of his property / to public charities

Reader / the world is open to thee, go thou and do likewise
