

Top (east facing)

In Memory of / Mr. Thomas Worsdale / who died July 6th 1767 aged 77 Years /

And of Elizabeth his Wife / who died October 8th 1768 aged 67 Years /

Mr. James White / (late of Chobham, Surrey), Surgeon / died 2 January 1830 / in the 24th Year of his Age /

Mr. Henry White / (Eldest and last surviving Brother / of the above) / died the 25th of September 1834 / in the 45th Year of his Age /

Sarah Wife of Mr. William Shaw / of this Parish, Surgeon / (youngest Sister / of the above) died 2nd May 1836 / in the 32nd Year of her Age /

Ann White / Sister of the above / who died at Brighton / on the 11th of February 1866 / in the 69th Year of her Age /

South side (now nearly covered by dusty/sooty accretions)

Here till the resurrection of the just rests all that was mortal of Letitia the beloved and saintly wife of Thos. Mortimer (B.D.) Minister of St. Marks Middleton Square Pentonville she fell asleep Sep. 30th 1836.
