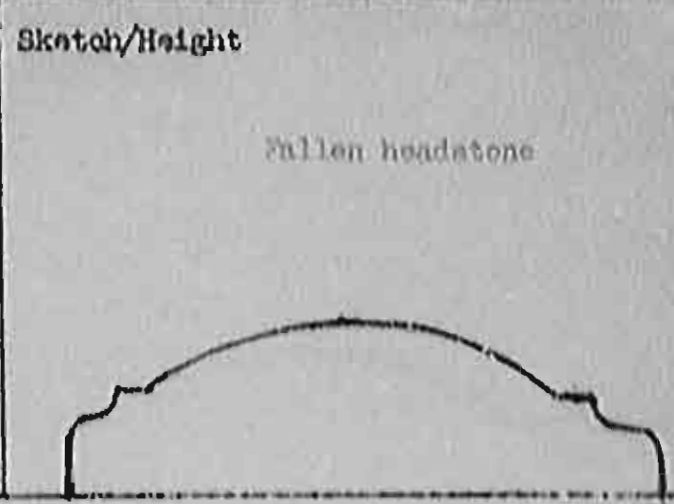

 this inscription is eroding, what is left looks more like 1800.)

 9th 1825 / Aged 39 Years /

Also Mrs. Rebecca Miller / Wife of the above / who died March 2nd 1841 /
 Aged 85 years /

Also Mrs. Jane Neal / wife of Mr. John Neal / and of the above Mr. Chas.
 Jordan / who died February 4th 1853 / aged 56 years /

Also of the above / Mr. John Neal / who died September 11th 1894 / aged
 59 years /
