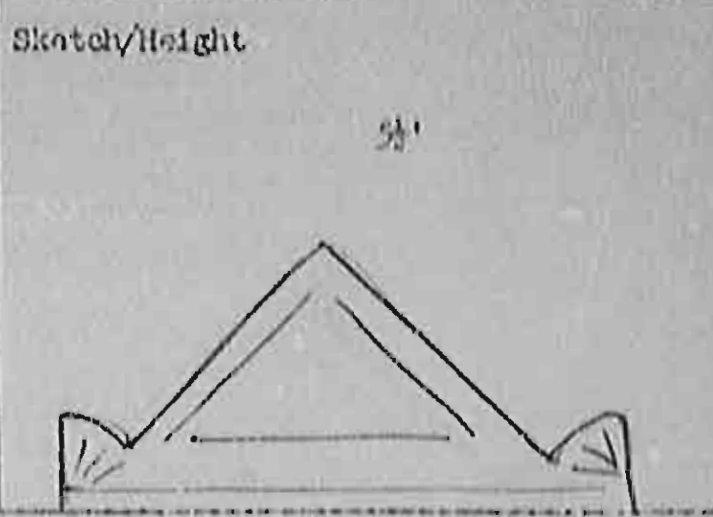

.. Memory of / Mrs. Margaret Stone / wife of Mr. Thos. Stonehouse / of this parish / who departed this life March ... 1817 / Aged 47 Years /

Also of Thomas Stonehouse / Eldest son of the above / who departed this life December ... 1853 / Aged 28 years /

Also of Jane Pries / only daughter of the above / who died in the Crimea Oct. .. 18.. / Aged 27 years /

East face

Sacred / to the memory of / Sarah Hunt / the beloved mother of Thomas Edward } Hunt / of this parish / who died March 28th 1869 / aged 66 years /
 The memory of the Just is blessed /

(This inscription is now eroding, and shows an odd confusion - it seems that the name of the son was originally wrongly engraved, the letters filled up and another name re-cut; but the state of the stone is now such that it is impossible to distinguish which is the error and which is the correct version.)
