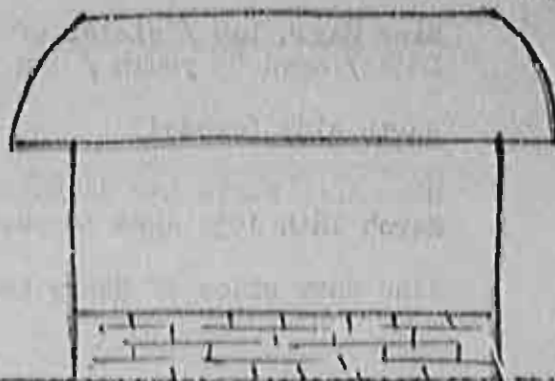

Here lyeth the body of Mrs. Anne Catherine Law who departed this life 7 June 1785 aged 25 years late wife of Mr. Henry Law of London merchant and daughter of the late Thomas Sheppard of Little Olfley in the County of Hertford.

Also of Mr. William Law son of the above Mr. Henry Law / who departed this life 23rd day of August 1833 / aged 36 Years /

East end

Jane / widow of the aforesaid / Mr. William Law / died 24 February 1847 / aged 48 years / and is buried at Abney Park /
