

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 988, tomb 710

East face

In memory of Mr. John Treasure late of the parish of St. Clements Dane who died Oct. 18th 1704 (sic Millward - more probably 1794) aged 66 years /

(Millward then says "rest buried", which is incorrect - a further three inscriptions at least existed.)

Also of Mrs. Elizabeth Treasure / Widow of the above / Died Jany. 10th 1803 / Aged 64 Years /

Also of Mr. Joseph Holt / Died March 20th 1808 / Aged 77 Years /

Also Samuel Holt / ..... / ..... / (break occurs here)
