 He held the office of examining clerk (Treasurer) normally and
 faithfully for 7 years under Sir Arthur Trevor, head of the assizes
 of the Court of Chancery; and would have held it for many years,
 as was to be wished; but removed by untimely death, he laid down his
 life and work to enjoy eternal rest; he died, regretted by his
 friends, an ornament to his office, 9 Dec. 1716, aged 25.)
